The beauty of the savannah, plains and crater can be appreciated all year round but between July and October the migration reaches fever pitch and offers the best chance to witness the tens of thousands of wildebeest, zebras and gazelles stampede back and forth across the Mara River in search of the fresh short grasses. On our way north we will visit the elephants of Tarangire and the large cats of the Central Serengeti.

After each exciting game drive, you can relax at our tented camps and lodges for sunsets, cocktails, camp fires, a superb dinner and a good night's sleep; ready for the next day's adventure.

DAY 1

- VIP collection from Kilimanjaro airport
- Afternoon Tarangire Game Drive*
- Arrive at the Simba Tarangire Tented Lodge
- Enjoy a drink on the verandah
- Dinner

**Note: This example is for early morning arrivals, for later arrivals we will overnight in Arusha instead before heading off to Tarangire in the morning.*

Tarangire is the perfect place to start any safari with the largest population of elephants with herds sometimes 200-strong. There are also over 700 lions that live permanently in the Tarangire.

The landscape is varied with grasslands and swamps and dotted with the majestic prehistoric Baobab trees and dissected by the Tarangire river.

For the bird-lovers, there are almost 600 species to track down.



DAY 2

- Breakfast in the camp
- Game drive in Tarangire
- Picnic lunch overlooking the Tarangire river
- Return to Simba Lodge
- Take a swim
- Drinks before dinner
- Restaurant for a buffet dinner
- Relax around the camp fire

Located near the new Sangaiwe Gate of Tarangire National Park. Tarangire Simba Lodge is situated in a wildlife-rich area with unhampered views to beautiful Lake Burunge, bordered by the park and a Wildlife Management Area. The setting is stunning; with a giant old Baobab tree anchoring one corner and a permeating feeling of real Africa.

In the evening, many animals are attracted to the camp and it is not unusual to see elephants visiting the pool.



DAY 3

- Game drive in Lake Manyara
- Picnic lunch
- Arrive at Eileen's Tree Lodge
- Go for a swim
- Pre-dinner drinks on the terrace
- Dinner
- Relax on the terrace and firepit

Lake Manyara National Park is one of the smaller parks but very much worth a visit. Starting from the south and exiting in the forest of the Great Rift Valley, we will visit open plains around Lake Manyara to see the hippos.

Lake Manyara is well known for the tree climbing lions, the soda ash lake that attracts thousands of pink flamingos and has one of Tanzania's biggest elephant populations and breath-taking scenery.

The lake is home to over 300 migratory birds long-crested eagles and grey-headed kingfisher.



DAY 4

- Breakfast
- Depart for Lake Eyasi
- Visit the Hadzabe Bushmen
- Visit the Datoga Tribe
- Return to Eileen's Tree Lodge
- Pre-dinner drinks on the terrace
- Dinner
- Relax on the terrace and firepit

The Hadzabe and Datoga tribes offer a fun and wonderful day out to experience the ancient ways of life of tribes that have existed in the region for thousands of years.

Eileen's Tree Inn is in the town of Karatu between the Ngorongoro crater, the Serengeti gateway, and Tarangire and Lake Manyara parks. The lodge is owned and managed by Tanzanians whose mission is to provide safari visitors with good value, comfortable accommodation and an authentic African welcome.

The guest rooms are set in beautiful tropical gardens and you'll find a bar, a small lounge area and a dining room in a rustic wooden building reminiscent of a tree house. The food is wonderful and the experience is entirely African which we think is a great way to start your safari.



DAY 5

The Ngorongoro Crater is inside the UNESCO World Heritage Site that is the Ngorongoro Conservation Area. We will first traverse the crater wall, stopping briefly for a breath-taking view of the entire crater before descending into the Ngorongoro Crater which has the highest density of wildlife in Africa.

The Ngorongoro Crater contains the 'big five' of game animals and you have a great chance to see them all.



DAY 6

Meaning ‘endless plains’ in the Maasai language, the Serengeti is undoubtedly one of the world’s most celebrated wilderness areas.

This area is crossed by the thrilling spectacle of the annual migration.

The Central Serengeti also has high-density game-viewing at all times and is well-known for its large concentration of cats, so much so that until recently this area was set aside for scientific research into predators, especially cheetah.

Matawi Serengeti Tented Camp is one of our favourite camps because it is spectacularly situated on the edge of Topi Hill, Seronera, which enjoys a panoramic view of the endless plains of the Serengeti, and this safari jewel combines luxury and authenticity and is the best of what a safari experience can offer.

The Mara River which flows through the Northern Serengeti to Lake Victoria in the West, is without a doubt the centrepiece of this isolated Serengeti region.

Now is the time to be in this exciting arena as thousands of wildebeest, zebras and gazelles will be edging to the river banks until the pressure is so strong behind that they launch themselves into the river to follow the fresh grass.

Serengeti Tanzania Bush Camp is the ultimate seasonal camp in Serengeti, inside touching distance of the Mara River at the heart of the best game viewing. Here, in this enormous remote wilderness, almost double the size of the Masai Mara, you will enjoy fabulous landscapes and tremendous game viewing with practically no crowds.


