





Introducing Safari Nyati: an exhilarating journey through the heart of Africa where the breathtaking landscapes and vibrant wildlife come together to create a once-in-a-lifetime safari experience. After a rejuvenating night at Pazuri Inn in Arusha, we prepare for an exhilarating journey as we fly into the Serengeti to witness the true magic of the migration and mingle with the elephants, giraffes and big cats.

Each day unfolds with exhilarating game drives, followed by evenings filled with relaxation as you enjoy spectacular sunsets, savour refreshing sundowners, gather around campfires, and indulge in gourmet dinners under the stars.



DAY 1: Arrival Day, VIP Collection and Transfer to Pazuri Inn

We will be eagerly awaiting you just outside the arrivals hall with an SUV to welcome you to Tanzania and drive you directly to your lodge to relax and acclimatise to the magical atmosphere that is Safari Africa.



Pazuri Inn, Arusha

DAY 2: Tarangire National Park and Tarangire Safari Lodge



Tarangire National Park

Tarangire is one of my favourite parks and is the sixth largest park in the country with 2,850 square kilometres of wilderness.

Elephants, and other animals, are always confident of finding water in Tarangire and in the driest of seasons they will dig the river bed or visit the swamp, a sort of water tank for the region. In desperate times, the elephants will strip the bark from the Baobab trees that define Tarangire and squeeze out the water.













Tarangire Safari Lodge

Since 1985, this family-owned & managed Tarangire Safari Lodge has been well known for its location and panoramic views. It caters for wildlife enthusiasts and those seeking rest and relaxation among one of Tanzania's most popular national parks.

Quintessential safari tents, with thatched roofs and large, mesh-screened windows, provide the perfect opportunity to connect with the sights and sounds of nature. Each tent has a comfortable verandah, ideal for bird and game viewing or reading your favourite book after a dusty safari.

With a choice of twin, double tents, or triple bungalows; all are equipped with en-suite bathrooms with solar-heated showers, ample cupboard space for your gear, and a cultural touch of local textiles.



DAY 3: Tarangire National Park and Kudu Lodge



Tarangire National Park

Today you will explore the deeper reaches of the Tarangire where the animals will have gathered around the marshes in search of water. There is something for everyone in Tarangire and for the ornithologists there are also almost 600 species of birds to admire. Being so large you need to spend time in Tarangire, exploring the different areas, and my personal favourite is Silale Swamp which has a wonderful picnic area.





Explore Mto Wa Mbu

As we leave Tarangire we will pass by the bustling town of Mto Wa Mbu which is a little micro hub for safari supplies and street food. We will take a break to amble around this fascinating town which is a hive of activity with safari-goers, guides and camp workers as they prepare for the adventure.

There is so much to explore in Mto Wa Mbu: youth art projects; the makonde wood carvers; you have the option of a banana plantation walk where you can enjoy a traditional family lunch and drink mbege, banana beer!

Your tour will finish in the bustling local market, where you can wander around stalls selling fruit and vegetables stalls, spices and meat. Your guide will stop and explain points of interest, and give you the opportunity to try and smell a variety of foods. A real treat for the senses!





Kudu Lodge, Karatu

Kudu Lodge offers outstanding hospitality, comfortable accommodation and pleasant surroundings, is situated at Karatu, the heart of the northern Tanzania safari circuit. Kudu Lodge nestles in eleven acres of rolling countryside, amidst mature trees and gardens, home to myriad birds and a tranquil and shady oasis hideaway for visitors— the perfect base for wildlife safaris.

After the exhilarating day out/safari, you can be assured of a friendly welcome to the comfort of the lodge/camp; your luxurious bed; a hot steaming shower; and an evening spent across the polished mahogany dining table or by the fragrant wood fire places; recounting your day's stories and adventures while being attended to by friendly and efficient staff.



DAY 4: Ngorongoro Crater and Narudi Camp, Seronera



Ngorongoro Crater Tour

The Ngorongoro Crater is the world's largest intact and unfilled volcanic caldera and the Ngorongoro Conservation Area's main tourists' attraction. It is the largest and most scenic crater in the Ngorongoro Conservation Area, with a large concentration of wildlife. It is also one of Africa's Seven Natural Wonders due to its breathtaking natural features. The Ngorongoro Crater is known as a home to over 25,000 animals, including the big five; elephants, buffaloes, rhinos, lions and leopards.

Other animals found in this crater include hippos, hyenas, warthogs, zebras, elands, gazelles, wildebeests, just to name a few. This makes Ngorongoro Crater probably the best site in Tanzania to spot and watch the big five as well as other wild species more easily.

DAY 5: Central Serengeti and Narudi Camp, Seronera



Serengeti Central Game Drive

Meaning 'endless plains' in the Maasai language, the Serengeti is undoubtedly one of the world's most celebrated wilderness areas.

The Central Serengeti also has high-density game-viewing at all times and is well-known for its large concentration of cats, so much so that until recently this area was set aside for scientific research into predators, especially cheetah.

The big 5 are on everyone's list, and you're sure to see most if not all, but we might stumble upon an aardvark or the elusive leopard or even a serval or caracal cat. The beauty of the Serengeti is that you never know what you will find. there is always a surprise!

After an exhilarating day of exploration, we will return to the comfort of the camp to refresh before dinner and then relax around the campfire under the stars.



DAY 6: Journey North and Serengeti Savannah Camp, Mara

We will leave camp early to take our time to enjoy the game drive towards the Mara River. Between June and November is the time to be in this exciting area as thousands of wildebeest, zebras and gazelles will be edging to the river banks until the pressure is so strong behind that they launch themselves into the river to follow the fresh grass. As we game drive around we will undoubtedly find some amazing sightings of the resident game in the surrounding area.





Serengeti Savannah Tented Camp, Kogatende

The spacious verandah in front of your room is furnished with comfortable safari chairs and tables – the perfect retreat for a relaxing moment watching a weaver bird building its nest in a nearby Acacia tree, a herd of impala grazing quietly only meters away, or simply relaxing and listening to the sounds of the African bush.



DAY 7: Mara River Serengeti and Serengeti Savannah Camp, Mara

Today will be another opportunity to witness the marvelous spectacle of the Great Migration as they prepare themselves for the long trek south along the eastern corridor.

In addition to the seasonal wildebeest occupying the lands there is much resident game with opportunities to see the big 5 and especially the cats in the rocky kopies and if you're lucky, a rhino strolling along the river banks.





Serengeti Savannah Tented Camp, Kogatende

The Serengeti Savannah Camp's Mara River Camp is located around the Kogatende wildebeest migration area, a stone throw away from the Mara River where the crocodile infested river flows through Kenya and Tanzania in the continent of Africa, intersecting the migration path of wildebeest and other animals in the Serengeti-Masai.



DAY 8: Fly to Zanzibar and Flame Tree Cottages
